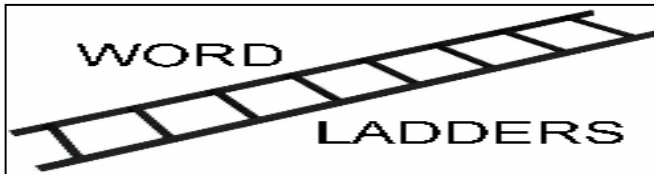

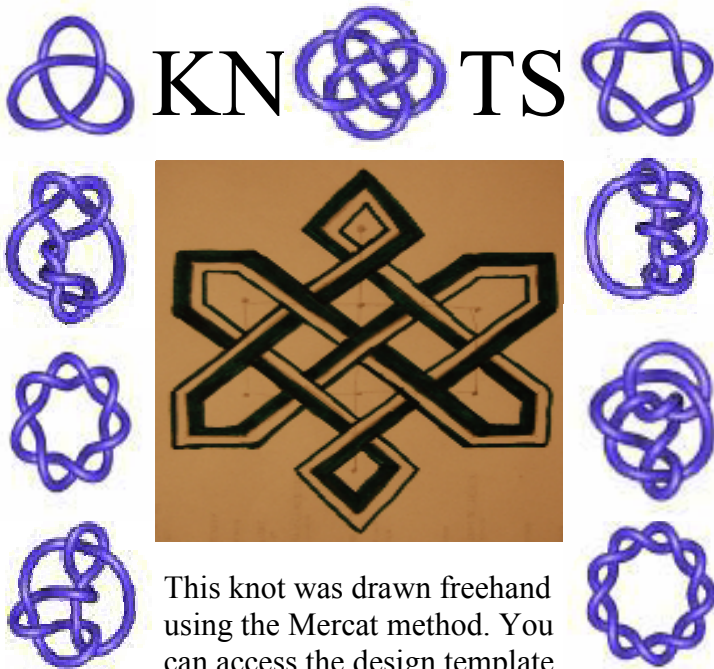

Here is a challenging word game that's better than Solitaire. Start with a five letter word. Now change 1 letter to make a new word. Give yourself 1 point if you changed the 1<sup>st</sup> letter, 2 points if you changed the 2<sup>nd</sup> letter, 3 for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4 for the 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5 points if you changed the last letter. Continue creating new 5 letter words by replacing one letter at a time. Now here's the catch: Once you insert a new letter it cannot be used again! You also cannot change the same position twice in a row!

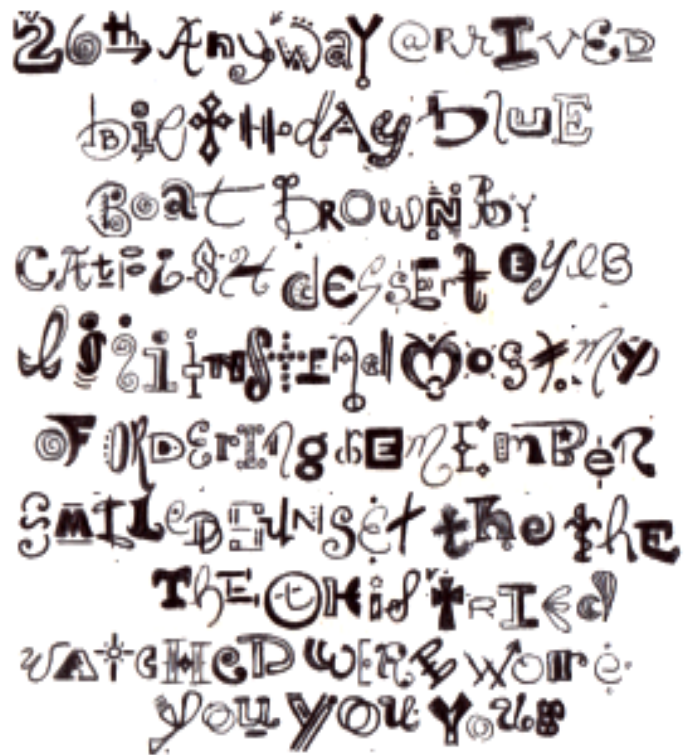
This knot was drawn freehand using the Mercat method. You can access the design template at the CIF resource page -
