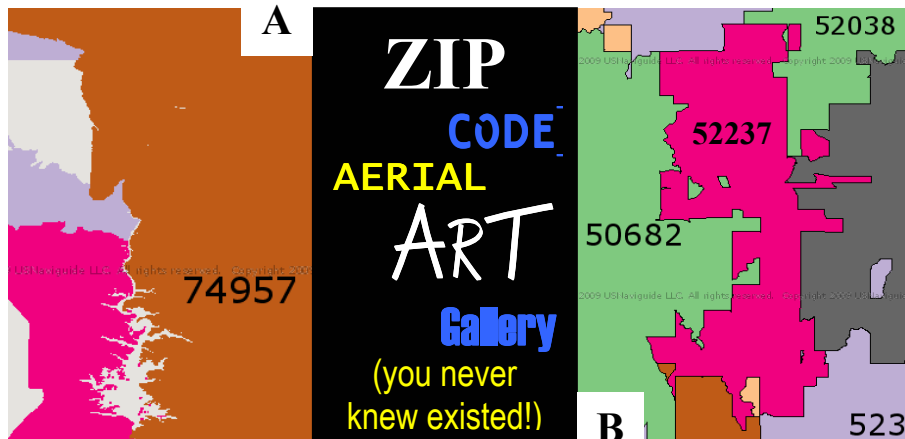


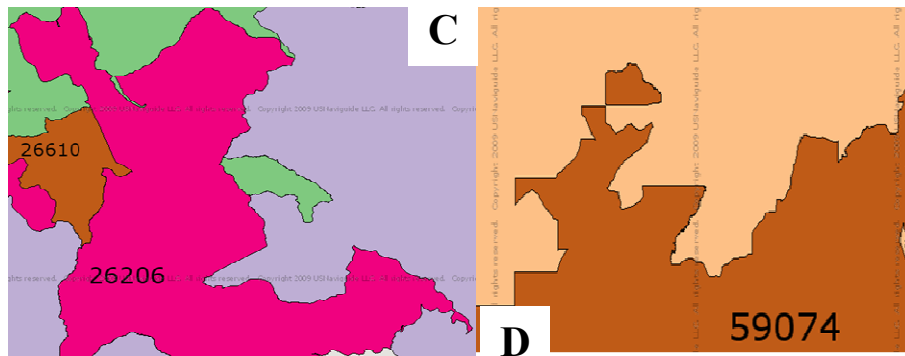

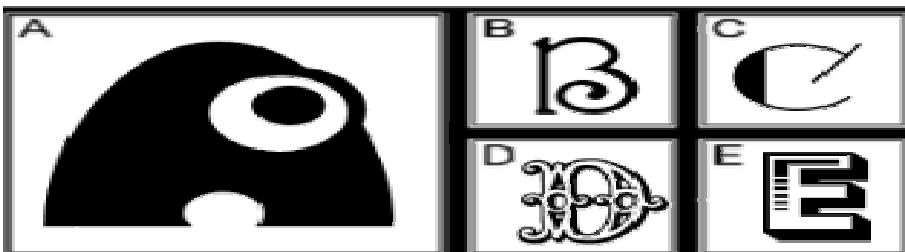

TOWER

This year marks the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Paris' most famous landmark, the 81-story iron icon built by Gustave Eiffel (the engineer who also built the framework for the Statue of Liberty!)

The Tower was dedicated as the entranceway to the 1889 World's Fair.
